Morning tea and refreshments will be provided.

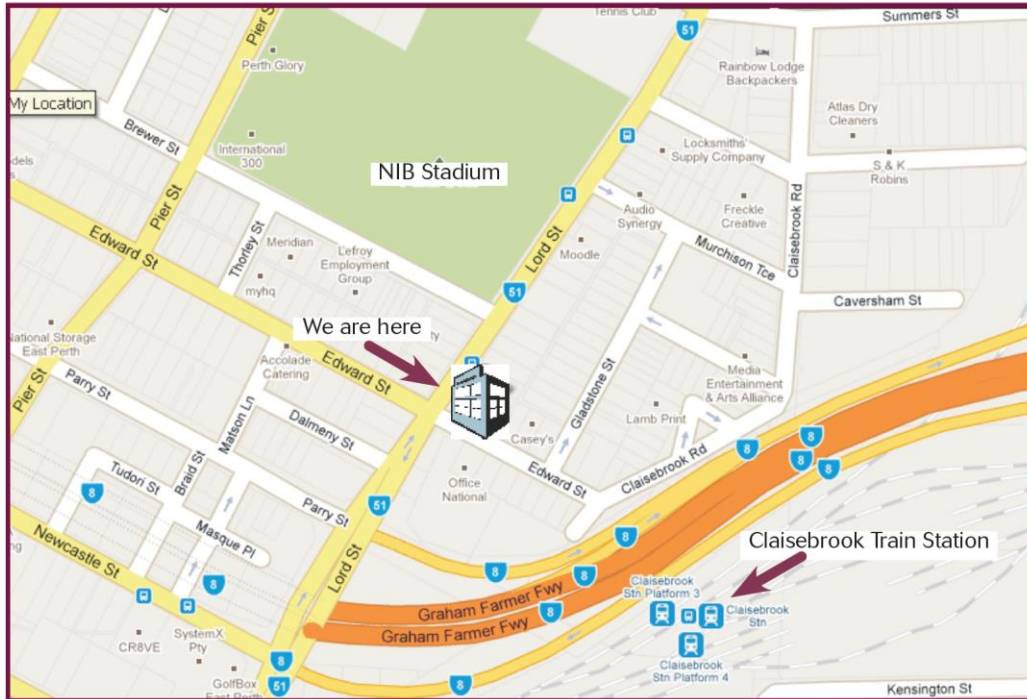
