


Government of Western Australia Mental Health Commission



BUDGET BREAKDOWN 2021-22

The 2021-22 State Budget will deliver more than a billion dollars (\$1.114 billion) to mental health, alcohol and other drug services in 2021-22, representing an increase of 10.9% (\$109.5 million) from the previous budget.
